STAR manages the procurement process through a category management approach. It comprises 3 category teams: People, Place and Professional. You will find separate listings from each of these teams.

We will endeavour to arrange appointments with the buying teams you request and will send an email confirming the details of your appointment(s) by Wednesday 7th November.
