STAR manages the procurement process through a category management approach. It comprises 3 category teams: People, Place and Professional. You will find separate listings from each of these teams.

If you believe your company is able to provide the goods/services the buyers are looking for, please submit the booking form by **5pm on the 18**<sup>th</sup> **October 2018.** All completed forms should be emailed to info@meetthebuyer.org.uk

Please be selective when selecting the buying teams you are requesting to meet and focus your application on those that have requested the goods/services you provide. You can choose up to 4 companies but we may need to limit appointments if demand is high.

We will endeavour to arrange appointments with the buying teams you request and will send an email confirming the details of your appointment(s) by Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> November.

Please note that no appointments will be made between companies and buying teams where there is no match in goods/services and buying requirements. In addition, whilst we will endeavour to match as many companies as possible with appointments, high demand means that appointments cannot be guaranteed.




